## Greater visibility of project costs

The face of retail is constantly evolving: from bricks and mortar stores to online shopping, the next trend is driven by ever-changing consumer habits. GameStop is a family of specialty retail brands across the US, Canada, Australia and Europe. The company is currently diversifying its business by adding wireless technology and collectibles to its existing video game business.

With 6,000 stores, 1,200 wireless stores and more than 50,000 employees, CA Project & Portfolio Management has given the retailer the visibility and foresight it needs to transform and grow its business.

As Marc Uptmore, CA Project & Portfolio Management Configuration Manager at GameStop explains, “Before we implemented the solution in 2011, project management was a paper-orientated, cumbersome process. With no visibility of real-time budget tracking or way to measure success, our executives were in the dark.”

Now, GameStop is making smarter IT investment decisions. “CA Project & Portfolio Management gives us a single view of our project data, helping us use our IT budget more wisely and better supporting the business,” adds Uptmore.

### Comprehensive project management

To safeguard its sales success, GameStop invests approximately 30 percent of its capital in IT. “We want to see 50 percent of our earnings coming from channels outside video game sales by 2019,” explains Debra Corder, Senior Manager, Project Management Office at GameStop. “We’re spending a significant portion of our budget to support new lines of business, kit out new stores and explore new tech brands.”

To manage these large-scale projects effectively, the retailer needs accurate data. Uptmore reveals, “CA Project & Portfolio Management simplifies management and reduces risk – we have red, yellow and green indicators defined around scope, timeline, financials and resources for each project. This not only improves visibility, but means we can get executive input on issues as soon as they arise.”
