

CA Privileged Access Manager 3.X: Use the Command Line Interface Tool and Java API 300



Course Overview

Enterprise organizations need a Next Generation Privileged Access Management Platform – enabling them to protect and manage systems and privileged users across hybrid environments, all from a single point of control.

CA PAM supports a graphical user interface (GUI), a command line interface (CLI), and a Java API. The GUI provides access to both Access and Credential Management functions through a web browser. The CLI permits the entry of a command, or file of commands, from a Windows or UNIX/Linux command line. The Java API gives access to similar capabilities from a Java program.

This course topic describes how to install and configure the Command Line Interface (CLI) tool and the JAVA API.
