## Course Overview

Enterprise organizations need a Next Generation Privileged Access Management Platform – enabling them to protect and manage systems and privileged users across hybrid environments, all from a single point of control.

This course topic describes how to use the Transparent Logon Learn Tool to create the transparent logon configuration files that automate your users' logons to RDP Applications (RemoteApps).

In this course, you will launch an RDP access method in learn mode. You will use the Learn Tool and Control Viewer to capture the fields of an SQL Server 2012 login form to create the XML configuration file. You will then test the configuration using the built in debug tool.

This course does not include configuring a CA PAM RDP Application with Transparent Logon. See the course topic *Control Access to RDP Published Applications* for that information.

- Use the Learn Tool and Control Viewer to capture specific fields of a RemoteApp logon form and build an XML configuration file
