You can now deploy REST API services as part of SSO WAMUI installation. The Rest API makes federation management fast, easy, and programmable. It also supports federation protocols for SAML 2.0, federation entities and partnerships, and certificates of all formats.

This course includes two demonstrations with accompanying labs. The first one explains how to create and manage agents, and how to export and import Policy Store Objects. The second shows how to create entities and partnerships, and how to activate, deactivate, and delete a Partnership using the APIs.
