CA Single Sign-On (SSO) provides a centralized security management foundation that enables secure use of the Web to deliver applications and data to customers, partners, and employees. This series of advanced topics are frequently implemented to extend the SSO environment, further enhance security, and improve performance.

CA Single Sign-On provides web services that enable applications not protected by a web agent to utilize your CA SSO infrastructure for authentication and authorization.

This course topic describes how to configure and enable the web services and test them with SoapUI. This course includes recorded demonstrations of the process, as well as a hands-on lab where you will perform the steps described and exercise the services in a fully-functional CA SSO environment.
